

EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

5. CONFIDENTIALITY

Employee agrees to maintain the confidentiality of all proprietary information, trade secrets, and confidential business information of Employer, both during and after employment.

6. NON-COMPETE

For a period of following termination, Employee agrees not to:

- a) Engage in any business that competes with Employer within
- b) Solicit any of Employer's clients or customers
- c) Solicit or hire any of Employer's employees

7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

All inventions, developments, and work product created by Employee during employment and related to Employer's business shall be the sole property of Employer.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of .
